Date: July 15, 2015 @ 4:45 PM

- Turkeyfoot Road Landscape Islands:
 - Lonkard Construction will install the manhole and underdrain as required by the State. Construction will begin once the state has approved the permit.
 - Merkle Lawn Care will install the irrigation and plants after Lonkard has completed their work. Plantings will go in in the fall.

- Turkeyfoot Road Sidewalks:
 - We are waiting on word from the State to begin preparing the construction documents for this project.
 - A letter from John Reedy (2659 Turkeyfoot Road) was discussed.

- 2015 Street Program:
 - The original start date for water main replacement on Flower, Locust, West Lakeside and Gilmore was July 20. Due to the poor weather the contractor is behind on other jobs so the start date will likely be delayed a couple of weeks. It is still anticipated that the water main work will be done by the end of September.
 - Michels Construction will begin the resurfacing project in October.

- Hudson Avenue Sanitary Sewer:
 - No update. Schedule is still as previously discussed unless we hear otherwise from SD1.

- Williams/Locust Repairs:
 - Project is complete.

- North Ashbrook Repairs:
 - Work will include concrete repairs on North Ashbrook and joint and crack sealing on North Ashbrook, Van Deren, Elizabeth, Yancey, Holaday and Williams.
 - Opinion of construction cost is \$90,000. Approximately \$70,000 is for concrete repair and \$20,000 is for joint and crack sealing.
 - Bids will be opened on July 30 and will be brought to the August council meeting.
 - Construction is anticipated to begin in August.

- The construction of a new home on Penwood Road will require that the new pavement on Penwood is cut and replaced in order to install the new sanitary sewer service line underneath the road. A copy of the City's utility cut ordinance was given to and discussed with the homeowner's representatives.

- Dave Schrand is installing lighting for the flagpole at Bellemonte Park.
