

LAKESIDE PARK-CRESTVIEW HILLS POLICE AUTHORITY BOARD

Regular Meeting – July 20, 2015

CALL TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Lakeside Park-Crestview Hills Police Authority Board was called to order at 5:29P.M. by Chairman Paul Markgraf.

5. Ptl. Jackson's mother-in-law donated a 46" television to the department & it was installed in our break room.

COUNCIL REPORTS: (Crestview Hills) Mr. Kramer stated that the city would like to possibly reexamine the funding formula for the Police Authority; the city is looking into the possibility of a stop sign @ Shinkle & Springside in Lookout Farm; they had a reading on an ordinance redefining parking on the city side of the city building parking lot.
